

HB 967 · COMPLIANT BY JANUARY 1, 2027

Your HB 967 Readiness Checklist

Four workstreams to move your office from today to compliant. Check each item off as you go, then work backward from the deadline.

Coverage audit

- ☐ List every payment type your office collects (fines, fees, taxes, permits, court costs, bonds, utilities)
- ☐ Mark which can be paid online today
- ☐ Anything unmarked is a compliance gap

Legal and policy

- ☐ Confirm with your attorney which obligation types fall under the mandate
- ☐ Decide whether to use the surcharge provision (agency-funded vs. constituent-funded)
- ☐ Identify payment types where another law requires a different form (these are exempt)

Procurement and approval

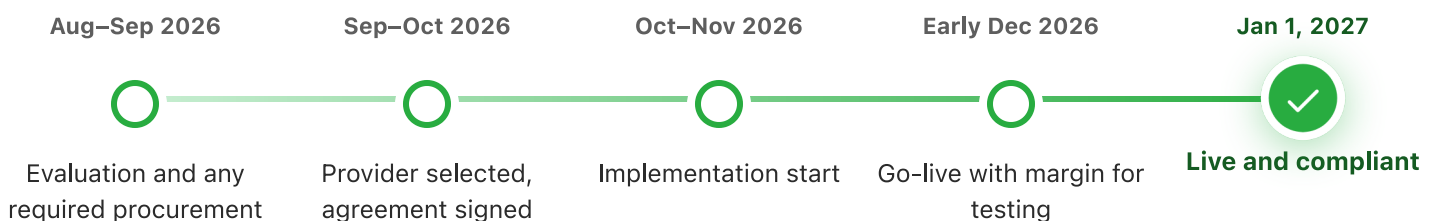
- ☐ Determine whether provider selection needs an RFP, RFQ, or board approval in your jurisdiction
- ☐ If so, count backward: approval cycles plus implementation must finish before January 1

Implementation

- ☐ Confirm your provider covers every obligation type, not just the easy ones
- ☐ Confirm after-hours constituent support
- ☐ Confirm reconciliation and reporting fit your finance processes
- ☐ Set a go-live target no later than early December

THE PATH TO JANUARY 1, 2027

Work backward from the deadline. These are the realistic latest dates to stay on track. Every Florida office is working against the same date, so implementation calendars fill from the front.
